FIRST READING

Isaiah 62:1-5 (NIV)

¹[The Lord speaks through the prophet Isaiah], "For Zion's sake I will not keep silent, for Jerusalem's sake I will not remain quiet, till her righteousness shines out like the dawn, her salvation like a blazing torch. ²The nations will see your righteousness, and all kings your glory; you will be called by a new name that the mouth of the Lord will bestow. ³You will be a crown of splendor in the Lord's hand, a royal diadem in the hand of your God. ⁴No longer will they call you Deserted, or name your land Desolate. But you will be called Hephzibah (which means 'my delight is in her') and your land Beulah (which means 'married'); for the Lord will take delight in you, and your land will be married. ⁵As a young man marries a maiden, so will your sons marry you; as a bridegroom rejoices over his bride, so will your God rejoice over you."

John 2:1-11 (God's Word)

¹Three days later a wedding took place in the city of Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there. ²Jesus and His disciples had been invited too. ³When the wine was gone, Jesus' mother said to Him, "They're out of wine." ⁴Jesus said to her, "Why did you come to Me? My time has not yet come." ⁵His mother told the servers, "Do whatever He tells you." ⁴Six stone water jars were there. They were used for Jewish purification rituals. Each jar held 18 to 27 gallons. ³Jesus told the servers, "Fill the jars with water." The servers filled the jars to the brim. ³Jesus said to them, "Pour some, and take it to the person in charge." The servers did as they were told. ¹The person in charge tasted the water that had become wine. He didn't know where it had come from, although the servers who had poured the water knew.
