AS WE GATHER

Speaking God's Word, the prophet Isaiah wanted the Judean exiles to know the confidence of belonging to God. His words to people who were tempted to "give up" on the Lord called for God's people to trust the truth: He's chosen us in the Messiah – our Savior Jesus. We are His own! "Write it on your hand" – you are "the Lord's!"

"You Are My Own" - Hymnwriter Gerry Coleman used this title for a hymn that describes God placing His loving claim on us through the waters of Baptism, connecting us to the life and death of Jesus for the forgiveness of our sins! What a blessing to be able to sing the words of this hymn: "His promise is 'I shall be always with you,' His covenant: 'You are My own!' "
